1 How old is the Beauty and the Beast story?

Over 250 years old! The original story was written in 1740 by a French lady with a reeeeally long name called Gabrielle-Suzanne Barbot de Villeneuve. Her version was meant for adults and was quite dark and scary. We would tell you more about it, but it would give you nightmares for weeks!

3 Were those really the first versions?

Probably not, no. People had been telling very similar stories for many years, but no one had bothered to write one down before Gabrielle.

2 Was that the only version?

No, there was a second version written 17 years later by another French lady with another looooong name called Jeanne Marie Leprince de Beaumont. She was rather cheeky and pinched Gabrielle's story for herself. She chucked out a lot of complicated backstory, like Beauty discovering she is the daughter of a king and a fairy (who isn't in the panto!), and made it more suitable for kids.

4 Why do lots of versions of the story call Beauty Belle??

Ah, that one's simple. 'Belle' is French for Beauty.

The original story is called La Belle et la bête.

There you go - now you've learnt the French word for Beast too.

5 How many adaptations of the story exist?

Too many to count. But here's a few of the strangest:

- Beauty and the Beast both attend an American high school (2011 film);
- Beauty is a New York lawyer and the Beast lives under the city (1980s TV series);
 - Beauty is a princess and the Beast is a werewolf (1962 film);
- Beauty and the Beast live in Viking times (2005 film);
- Beauty is a cop and the Beast is a science experiment gone wrong; together, they solve crimes (2012 TV series).

7 Are there any other famous ones?

Yes, there was also a French film in 1946 called...you guessed it, La Belle et la bête. We'd tell you more about it, but we only know two French words.

9 What's the wolf and message of Beauty and the Beast?

The main message is: don't judge someone by their looks.

Just because someone isn't considered pretty on the outside doesn't mean they aren't a nice person on the inside. This works both ways: sometimes pretty people can turn out to be the biggest meanies.

10 What other stories have been inspiried by Beauty and the Beast?

6 What's the most famous version?

Most people tend to remember the 1991
Disney film. It was a pretty big deal because
it was the first animated film to ever be
nominated for Best Picture at the Oscars.
Did you know Disney had first started
planning that film in the 1930s?
It took them over 50 years
to figure it out.

8 What is the Beast supposed to look like?

Different stories have had different ideas.

Nowadays, people tend to
depict him as a lion.
This is because that's how
he looked in the 1946 film.
There are also versions where he
looks like a boar, a stag, a frog, a
wolf and a bison. That's one scary
combo!

- Shrek a horrible green ogre falls in love with a princess (who is secretly an ogre too).
- The Hunchback of Notre-Dame a hunchback falls in love with a gypsy girl.
- The Thing from the comic book
 Fantastic Four a man made of rock falls in love with a blind woman.
- Jane Eyre a governess falls in love with a moody man called Mr Rochester.





Beauty's SuDoku


To while away the hours wandering in the Beast's rose garden, Beauty passed the time making up sudoku puzzles.

The first one she made had 16 squares, divided into four smaller boxes of four squares each. The idea is to fill it so that every row and column of the large grid and every smaller 2 x 2 box contains each of the four numbers inside the roses.

Can you solve it?



The next puzzle she made was even harder - she made the grid bigger, so that each row, column and box has six squares. See if you can do this one!





Why not tempt your friends with these deliciously wicked cupcakes?



Ask an adult to help you! First we need to make our cupcakes. These are the ingredients you will need to make 12:


Two large eggs • One tsp vanilla essence
Two tbsp cocoa powder • 125g/40z caster sugar
125g/40z soft margarine
125g/40z self-raising flour

- Turn on the oven and heat it up to 180°C/350°F/Gas Mark 4.
- 2 Crack the eggs into a bowl and beat lightly with a fork.
- 3 Add the other ingredients and beat until you have a smooth mixture.
- 4 Put 12 cake cases on a baking sheet and half-fill each of them with the mixture.
- 5 Cook the cakes for 18 20 minutes. You can easily tell when they are done when they have risen up and spring back into shape when lightly pressed.

Now to make them beastly!

For this, you'll need some marshmallows, a big bar of milk chocolate and some sweets to use for faces.

- Melt the milk chocolate in a glass bowl in the microwave, or over a saucepan of simmering water.
- 2 Dip the marshmallows into the melted chocolate and swirl them around to cover them. Bring them out and lay them flat on a paper plate for the chocolate to harden.
- 3 Now use your imagination and decorate them with sweets to make them as beastly as you can! For the face, you could use chocolate buttons for eyes and strawberry laces to do a mouth.
- Finally, use some of the melted chocolate to stick them on top of the cakes.
